WHY MISSION UNIVERSITY? New Day

It is a hard time for Christian colleges. Since 2016, 52 non-profit colleges and universities have been forced to close, 15 of those in 2023. Few of you know how close BBC came to being a part of those statistics. The college has faced and overcome substantial crises. When President Milioni arrived in 2012, the College faced serious financial problems. \$1.5 million was owed to local vendors alone. Through much prayer, the support of our ministry partners and alumni, and lots of hard work, those debts were paid. Then, the deteriorating conditions of campus buildings had to be addressed. Major updates to roofs, electrical, and heating systems had to be made to protect the integrity of our buildings. Then, the College was placed on academic probation by the Higher Learning Commission in 2016. Many colleges do not survive this serious accreditation issue, but our team dug in and began the difficult process of reevaluating each and every academic process. These efforts made us stronger, better, and ready to face the future. Probation was removed in 2019, and today, we have the strongest academic standing in our history! These issues had a negative impact on recruiting and enrollment.

But today is a new day! Our enrollment has increased by 20% in each of the past three years. We are now in a good position to face the future and are excited about what the future holds!

New Way

Our country is facing a culture that is doing everything possible to force its way upon our youth. Most colleges have given in and do all they can to promote liberal agendas and indoctrinate students with alternative, ungodly lifestyles. We have made it very clear who we are. We believe the Bible and what God's Word clearly teaches about creation and sexuality. We are finding many families that are so thankful for a college where biblical morality and biblical worldview are taught.

Our name is changing, but there are many things that will remain the same. Our atmosphere, our heart for the Bible, our purpose, our student life, our love for the local church, a burden for people to know Jesus, and our love for each other will remain. Our school of ministry studies will still be called Baptist Bible College and Theological Seminary.
